I am requesting funding for the Advanced Intersection Analytics Program in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada, located at 600 S Grand Central Parkway, Suite 350, Las Vegas, Nevada 89106.

The funding will be used for the deployment of Advanced Intersection Analytics at 20 signalized intersections across the Las Vegas metro area to provide local agencies with enhanced safety insights in real-time to more efficiently develop safety action plans and remediation.
