Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Vision Zero School Safety project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Las Vegas, located at 495 S. Main Street, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101.

The funding will support implementation of the City of Las Vegas Vision Zero School Safety Program, which focuses on improving transportation safety near schools where children and other vulnerable road users are most at risk. The City has established a structured prioritization process that evaluates schools across all six wards using factors such as traffic volumes, roadway characteristics, crash history, proximity to the High Injury Network, and whether the school is located within a community of concern.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because many of these campuses are situated near major arterial corridors or segments of the City's High Injury Network where traffic speeds, roadway width, and crash patterns create challenging conditions for students walking or biking to school.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 133.
