I am requesting funding for the Eastside Education and Training Center in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the College of Southern Nevada, located at 6375 W. Charleston Boulevard, Las Vegas, Nevada 89146.

The funding will provide primarily adult residents with short-term basic education, ESL, and entry level skill training in advanced manufacturing, construction skills, logistics & operations, welding, information technology, and healthcare.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will serve a “higher education desert” with an underserved population. CSN is the only avenue to higher education for the adult population in this area which suffered the high unemployment impact of the pandemic and previously the Great Recession. For thousands, this will be the opportunity to enter a new career pathway to employment in a growing industry sector and obtain a job with family sustaining wages.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
