Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Eastside Parks Lighting Improvement project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Clark County, Nevada, located at 500 S. Grand Central Parkway, Las Vegas, Nevada 89155.

The funding will support the replacement of outdated outdoor and sports field lighting systems at Sunrise Park, Winterwood Park, and Maslow Park with high-efficiency LED fixtures to improve public safety, enhance recreational usability, and reduce long-term energy and maintenance costs.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because upgrading to modern LED technology will significantly reduce electricity consumption, lower maintenance frequency, and extend fixture lifespan, resulting in sustained operational savings for the County. It also represents a strategic investment in aging public infrastructure at three heavily utilized community parks within Nevada's First Congressional District.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
