Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for High Injury Network Intersection Safety Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Las Vegas, located at 495 S. Main Street, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101.

The funding will be used to target safety improvements at intersections located on the City of Las Vegas High Injury Network (HIN), where the majority of the most severe crashes occur. Although these corridors represent only 11% of the roadway network, they account for 77% of all serious injuries and fatal crashes. By concentrating investments at these high-risk locations, the City can implement FHWA-proven safety countermeasures where they will have the greatest impact.

The project is a responsible use of taxpayer funds because these improvements ensure resources are directed toward locations where safety benefits will be greatest, delivering measurable reductions in severe crashes while improving overall roadway operations and reliability.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 133.
