Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Dual Direction Bus Shelters project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) of Southern Nevada, located at 600 South Grand Central Parkway, Suite 350, Las Vegas, Nevada 89106.

The purpose of the project is to address the impact of extreme heat in communities and enhance comfort and safety for transit riders along several high-ridership bus routes by installing and/or upgrading 120 shelters specifically designed to provide all-day shade.

This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because extreme heat presents a public health risk for individuals who rely on walking, biking, and transit for their daily mobility needs. This project allows RTC to proactively address comfort and safety concerns by adding shelters where none currently exists and mitigating the impacts of extreme heat on transit riders in the region.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by chapter 53 of title 49 of the United States Code.
