Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Vision Zero School Zone Safety Improvements in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Las Vegas, located at 495 South Main Street, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101.

The purpose of the project is to implement transportation safety enhancements for 281 school zone locations throughout the City of Las Vegas as part of its Vision Zero Action Plan which aims to eliminate traffic fatalities and serious injuries by 2050.

This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because nearly 25% of the City of Las Vegas's school zones are located along High Injury Network (HIN) corridors where traffic fatalities and serious injuries are heavily concentrated. Enhanced operation and maintenance of flasher systems in school zones will help reduce child fatalities and advance the City's commitment to proactively improve transportation safety through the implementation of its Vision Zero program.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 133.
