Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Flamingo Water Resources Center Emergency Power Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Clark County Water Reclamation District, located at 5857 E Flamingo Rd Las Vegas, NV 89122.

The funding would be used for planning and implementation costs to facilitate the development of an emergency power plan for the Flamingo Water Resources Center, including future installation of generators that will provide new resilience for the facility to manage biological processes during outages and maintain a level of treatment to avoid an incursion or overflow of wastewater.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will make the water district less likely to request additional federal and state resources for temporary power or require additional resources due to a prolonged loss of power in the future.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 203 of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5133), as amended by Section 1234, National Public Infrastructure Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation, of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act (DRRA) of 2018.
