Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Vertical Transportation Improvements at LAS Airport project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Clark County Department of Aviation, located at 5757 Wayne Newton Boulevard, Las Vegas, NV 89119.

The funding would be used for adding elevators and escalators in the public garage and baggage claim area as recommended by a recently completed LAS Landside Operations study. The improved vertical movement within the building and garage will result in greater safety with better separation of passengers and vehicles on airport roadways.

This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it will enhance the accessibility, reliability, safety, and energy efficiency of vertical transportation systems at LAS Terminal 1. It will improve the capacity of the airport and elevate the travel experience for over 16 million passengers annually.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 49 U.S.C. 47100 et seq, and it will enhance airport safety.
