I am requesting funding for the Vision Zero Program Implementation project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Las Vegas, located at 495 S. Main Street, Las Vegas, NV 89101.

The purpose of the project is to enhance transportation safety along a number of corridors that have been identified as a "High Injury Network" as part of the City's Vision Zero Action Plan where traffic fatalities and serious injuries are heavily concentrated.
