I am requesting community project funding for the Lower Las Vegas Wash at Lake Mead in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation.

The funding would be used to construct erosion control structures in the Lower Wash in the NPS Lake Mead National Recreation Area which will reduce the sediment load for the primary drinking water source in Southern Nevada.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will protect existing infrastructure, restore surrounding wetlands, and improve drinking water quality for the region.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 529(b)(3) of the Water Resources Development Act of 2000.
