Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting community project funding for the Nevada Department of Transportation's Pavement Rehabilitation, Structure Improvements, Hydraulic Modifications, and Environmental Improvements on US 93 South of Henderson to Boulder City and on SR 173 South of US 93 to I-11 project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Nevada Department of Transportation, located at 1263 South Stewart Street., Carson City, NV 89712.

The funding would be used for the rehabilitation of the existing aging pavement, analyzing and upgrading existing hydraulic drainage facilities, repairing and overlaying existing bridge decks to preserve and protect structural integrity of the existing features, and repairing and installing new tortoise fence to protect the endangered species habitat located withing the project limits to promote environmental stewardship.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it protects endangered species habitat; preserves existing infrastructure; and enhances its resiliency through proven best practices for hydraulics, stormwater, and pavement preservation, thus saving money that would be needed for full reconstruction in the future.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 133(b).
