A BILL

To require the Administrator of the General Services Administration to submit a report describing a process for seeking public comment about proposed changes to mandatory design standards for public buildings, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REVISION OF DESIGN STANDARDS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 6 months after the
5 date of enactment of this section, the Administrator of the
6 General Services Administration shall revise the process
7 by which the Administrator updates or changes any P100

1 guidance document or other guidance document estab-
2 lishing mandatory design standards and performance cri-
3 teria for federally owned buildings under the custody of
4 the Administration.

5 (b) PROCESS.—The Administrator shall ensure that
6 the process revised under subsection (a) requires—

7 (1) a public comment period for any updates or
8 changes to the documents described in such sub-
9 section;

10 (2) publication of such updates or changes in
11 the Federal Register and on the website of the Gen-
12 eral Services Administration; and

13 (3) a summary of any comments received dur-
14 ing such public comment period.

15 (c) REPORT.—The Administrator shall submit to the
16 Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the
17 House of Representatives and the Committee on Environ-
18 ment and Public Works of the Senate a report describing
19 the revisions to the process required under subsection (a).
